**Pastoral Message:**

**Your Attitude Determines Your Altitude**

*"And Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it. But the men that went up with him said, We be not able to go up against the people; for they are stronger than we" Numbers 13:30-31 (KJV)*

In 1951 Sir Edmund Hillary and friends attempted to climb to the summit (peak) of Mt. Everest which is the highest peak in the world with a height of 8,848 metres (29,029 ft). That 1951 expedition was a failure, as they could not make it to the peak and had to return back. However, Sir Edmund refused to give up and his attitude was that it was possible for humans to conquer Mt. Everest. Two years later, on the 29<sup>th</sup> May, 1953 Sir Edmund Hillary and Tenzing Norgay became the first mortals in history to reach the peak of Mt. Everest!

Your attitude in life determines your altitude in life! How high up you will go this year 2018 will be determined by your attitude in this year 2018. All things are possible, only believe (Mark 9:23). Caleb's attitude was that it was possible to conquer the Canaanites and take the land and that was what God helped him to accomplish but his friends believed that it was not possible and they all perished in the wilderness and never got to the Promised Land. ## SUNDAY SCHOOL

### TOPIC: INTEGRITY (Part 2)

**MEMORY VERSE:** " And the LORD said unto Satan, hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God and escheweth evil?" Job 1:8

### **BIBLE PASSAGE: Genesis 39:1-13**

**INTRODUCTION:** Men and women of integrity are very few, even among the so called children of God. Are you a man or woman integrity? Can God vouch for you as He did for Job (Job 2:3)? King David in Psalm 25:21 affirmed by saying "let integrity and uprightness preserve me; for I wait on thee".

### **LESSON OUTLINES:**

#### **1. BIBLICAL HEROES OF INTEGRITY**

The Bible has records of people that exhibited integrity. They include among others Abimelech, King of Gerar (Genesis 20:3-7), Joseph (Genesis 47:14), Samuel (1Samuel 12:3-4), King David (1Kings 9:4), Job (Job 2:3,9-10), Apostle Paul (Acts 20:32-33) and our Lord Jesus Christ (John 14:30).

#### **2. SCOPE AND REWARDS OF INTEGRITY**

As believers, we need to demonstrate integrity in all aspects of human endeavours. In speech (James 1:19; Proverbs 8:7-8), in time management (Ephesians 5:15-17; John 9:4), in finance

(1Corinthians 4:2; Genesis 47:14), in relationship with the opposite sex (1 Corinthians 5:1; 1Samuel 2:12, 22-23; Judges 14:1,4), in keeping promises and paying vows (Ecclesiastes 5:4-5), etc. Integrity, although costly, has great rewards. These include: God vouching for you (Job 2:3), keeps you from falling into sin (Genesis 39:9), brings peace (Psalm 37:47), guides one's steps (Proverbs 11:3), preserves a man (Psalm 25:21-22), and brings generational blessings (Proverbs 20:7).

### **CONCLUSION**

God is pure and He expects His children to be pure too (Matthew 5:48; 2 Timothy 2:19). No matter your claims, if you are not a man or woman of integrity, your Christianity is questionable. Remember that only the pure in heart shall see God (Matthew 5:8).
