

How the Apostles died: Matthew

Matthew (Greek name meaning "Gift of God") was believed to be the most educated of all the 12 Apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ. He was a wealthy tax collector before Jesus called him to follow Him. Christian tradition believes he preached in Ethiopia (in Africa), Judea (Israel today), Macedonia, Syria and Parthia (northeast Iran). There are various accounts of his death and one of the accounts records that he was martyred in Ethiopia in 65 AD.

Pastoral Message: Don't Give Up 2!

"He also spoke a parable to them that they must always pray, and not give up"
Luke 18:1 (WEB)

"A middle-aged man from New Zealand painfully hauled himself up the last few feet to the summit of Mount Everest in May, 2006. Nothing so unusual in that - after all, climbing Everest has become so popular that its slopes are often crowded, and more than 100 people have scaled the mountain already that year - but Mark Inglis is different: he has no legs. Mark Inglis, 47, reached the peak of the world's tallest mountain on 16/05/2006, phoning his wife Anne on the South Island to say he had made it and returned to his party's base camp. Mount Everest is 29,035ft high and Inglis had spent a gruelling 40 days on the mountain!"

By dogged determination, Inglis, a double amputee reached the summit of Everest. What a great lesson for us never to give up in the place of prayer and in our walk with God no matter how hard and difficult things may seem to be! Many believers pray and when it seems as if God is delaying to answer them they turn aside to man-made alternatives instead of persevering in unwavering faith in the place of prayer. If there is a man to pray, there is a God to answer but we must pray in faith and not waver until the answer comes (James 1:5-6). We must pray in holiness because God is Holy. Sin is one of the greatest hindrances to prayer (Psalm 66:18; Isaiah 59:1-2). No matter what you are passing through today and no matter what you will pass through tomorrow, always remember we serve a very BIG GOD who can do all things and with whom there is no impossibility. He gives strength and courage for us to overcome (Isaiah 40:29). Don't give up and don't give in to negative suggestions because your miracle is on the way! Selah.
