## Pastoral Message:

### What You Say Is What You See!

“Say unto them, As truly as I live, saith the Lord, as ye have spoken in mine ears, so will I do to you” Numbers 14:28.

Be careful what you say because what you say is what you see! The children of Israel said they would die in the wilderness in Numbers 14:28 and God declared that He would do for them exactly what they have said in His ears! Many believers are careless about the words that proceed from their mouths. They say so many negative things about themselves and their destinies. No wonder, if you look at their lives you see a lot of negativities in their lives. From this day and the rest of your life decide never to say anything negative about your life and circumstances because what you say is what you see!

Some years ago the Lord led us to build a 2500 capacity Church auditorium in a remote location in North eastern Nigeria, where the largest cathedral takes just about 1000-1500 people. A Pastor said to me to me, doubtingly, he hopes to see the building completed in his life time and a retired army General said the project was too ambitious! The largest cathedral in the town had taken about 20 years to complete and was still not fully completed. But we prayed, believed God and kept declaring that it was going to be done. Within a year the building had reached roofing stage in a land whose terrain was very difficult to build on, and within 2 years the Lord had completed the building enough for services to begin there! What you say is what you see! Daddy G.O. said we would build a 3KM by 3KM auditorium at the Redemption City and many found it hard to believe but today we are seeing it already! What you say is what you see and whosoever can have whatsoever!

**SUNDAY SCHOOL  
TOPIC: ENVY AND  
JEALOUSY**

**MEMORY VERSE:** "And they said one to another, Behold, this dreamer cometh?" Genesis 37:19

**BIBLE PASSAGE: Genesis 37:3-4, 9-11**

**INTRODUCTION:** Envy comes from the Latin word: "*in video*" meaning to see against or look with ill mind. Jealousy involves suspicious fear or apprehension. While envy denotes a longing possess something awarded to or achieved by another (Genesis 26:14; 30:1), jealousy denotes a feeling or resentment that another has gained something one may desire (1 Samuel 18:6-9). Envy and jealousy are works of the flesh. They are traits of the Christian's former ways of life which need to be completely dealt with (Titus 3:3).

**LESSON OUTLINES:**

**1. EVIL EFFECTS OF ENVY AND JEALOUSY**

1. Envy or jealousy can deny one from inheriting the kingdom of God (Galatians 5:19-21)
2. It could lead to anger, self-destruction or divine wrath (Genesis 27:41; Proverbs 27:4; Numbers 12:5-10)
3. It could create an avenue of separation from God (1 Samuel 18:7-10)
4. It could also bring about personal harm or weakens one's physical, spiritual and emotional well-being (Job 5:2; Proverbs 14:30)
5. It manifests the

deceitfulness of sin and human immorality apart from the intervention of God's redeeming grace (Romans 1:28-32)

6. It could tear believers apart (Genesis 13:7-8; 1 Corinthians 3:3-5)

7. It can degenerate to gang up against others (Daniel 6:3-4)

**2. HOW TO OVERCOME ENVY AND JEALOUSY**

1. Be content with what you have (Proverbs 15:16; 1 Timothy 6:6)
2. Deal with the thought of envy or jealousy and do not allow it have a foothold in your mind (Romans 12:2; 1 Samuel 18:8)
3. Let the faithful avoid the company of the ungodly people (Psalms 1:1; 2 Corinthians 6:14-16)
4. Allow the power of the Holy Spirit to subdue all forms of carnality by walking in the Spirit (1 Corinthians 3:3; Galatians 5:16; 1 Peter 2:1)
5. Make the word of God your guide and the grace of God your support (Psalm 119:11, 105; Colossians 3:16)

**CONCLUSION**

Whoever envies or is jealous of another confesses the superiority of that person and we do not need to be blinded by these against our own weaknesses or sins. When we understand where these feelings of discomfort come from, we can learn to deal with same in more healthy and adaptive ways.
