## THE FIVE MOST IMPORTANT QUESTIONS IN LIFE

In life there are certain questions that are important and there are some that may not be very important. Dr. Myles Munroe conducted a research for many years and concluded that the five most important questions in life are the following:

1. Who am I? (Identity)
2. Where am I from? (Source)
3. Why am I here? (Purpose)
4. What can I do? (Potential)
5. Where am I going? (Destiny)

Philosophers, scholars and psychologists have tried for many years to answer these all important questions but have failed woefully! This is because these are not just ordinary questions but questions of eternal implications that require a divine answer. You cannot answer these questions without the help of the One who created you and who knows you more than you know yourself.

Several years ago a young man bought a Model T Ford car. One day as he was driving the car it broke down on the road and he stopped by the road side to try to fix it up because he knew a lot about cars. He tried several things on the engine and tried several times to crank the engine but it would not start. He, stubbornly like many of us, refused to call for help but rather did all he knew to get the engine to start but in vain! A few minutes later a Limousine pulled up beside him. Out of the car stepped out an elderly man who just stood and watched the young man for a few minutes. Finally the elderly man looked at the young man and told him to adjust a specific part on the engine. The young man thought to himself there is no way this old man can know more about cars than himself but he reluctantly agreed to adjust the part suggested by the elderly man since he had nothing to lose by trying. After adjusting that part of the engine, he tried to crank the engine back to life and sure enough it cranked back to life. Surprised, the young man asked the elderly man “how did you know what to do?” The elderly man replied “My name is Henry Ford and I invented this car”.
